Temporary Visitors Policy

Residential Services Department

Effective November and December 2020

Families may visit Community Homes during the holiday season; however, they should call the Residential On-site Manager in advance to schedule their visit.

- Please know that visitors will be required to follow corporate protocols during their visit:
- No more than two family members may visit at one time.
- Family members will be contacted to conduct a pre-health screening questionnaire within one hour prior to the visit
- Before entering the home, visitors will have their temperature taken. If a temperature is above 98.6 the visitor may not enter the home.
- Visitors will be expected to wear full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) including KN95/N95 mask, face shield, gown and gloves. If visitors do not have the required PPE, a PPE Kit can be purchased in advance by contacting Brooke Wagner, RN, Day Services Health Coordinator at 610-372-4737, ext. 703. The cost of the packet is \$15.00.
- If possible, visits should be held outside or in a designated room away from others.
- Eating and drinking on the premises will be prohibited because that would require visitors to remove their mask.
- Family members who wish to take their loved one out of the Community Home for travel out of the state must know that travel will require the participant and travelling companions to quarantine for 14 days with no COVID-19 symptoms prior to returning to the Community Home.
- We are discouraging any visits away from the community home at this time and hope that everyone understands we are trying to protect all individuals who live together and out employees.
- Thank you for helping us to keep everyone safe this holiday season!

This policy may change at anytime based on ODP requirements, CDC or PA Department of Health requirements.
